



## **REQUIREMENTS FOR CREDENTIALLING FOR 2011 FOR THOSE WHO HAVE NOT COMPLETED AN APPROVED RESIDENCY PROGRAMME**

In order to qualify for the examination your credential application must first be approved.

For 2011 only, candidates do not have to complete a residency program to apply for credentials. If you have the equivalent requirements of a residency program, you may fill out the credentialing application as well as provide documentation that you have the equivalent requirements to a resident and if approved you will be qualified to apply to write the examination.

Please insure that you explain how you received your education either through lectures, courses, seminars, tutorials or self directed study (e.g. articles, books) in the following areas which are also described in the document entitled Requirements for a residency programme for ECVBM-CA

1. Full theoretical knowledge of canine, feline, equine and exotic species behaviour
2. Ethology
3. Domestication
4. Animal welfare science
5. Animal learning
6. Functional anatomy and physiology of nervous and endocrine system
7. Genetics
8. Psychopharmacology
9. Family psychology
10. Animal law
11. Interaction between health and behaviour
12. Research methods either through lecture courses, tutorials, seminars, or partly through directed private study
